Cabarrus Co. releases top needs

CABARRUS COUNTY -- The top needs for Cabarrus County mirror problems facing the rest of North Carolina.



The county conducts a community needs assessment every four years.

After a year of collecting data, county officials released results of a community needs assessment for the area. Six issues were identified. They include workforce development, education, accessible and affordable mental health services, safe and sustainable housing, healthy living support and affordable healthcare.

“We want take the temperature of the community and understand what the needs are that we are facing and those needs change somewhat over time,” said Gina Goff, executive director of Healthy Cabarrus. “Some of the things stay the same over time as well. But it gives us a broad agenda that we can work on needs together.”
