Kannapolis to start code enforcement campaign

Kannapolis is starting a code enforcement campaign to educate residents and business owners about the city's zoning and appearance codes.

City officials will hold public meetings, beginning Thursday, with property owners on Cannon Boulevard and the Carver neighborhood to educate them about what is and what is not allowed under the city's ordinances.

The city will hold two meetings Thursday and Friday at the train station, 201 S. Main St. Both meetings start at 6 p.m. Cannon Boulevard property owners will meeting on Thursday and Carver area property owners will meet Friday.

Once the education classes ends in early February, code enforcement officers will begin enforcing code violations more aggressively. The program will continue into other areas throughout the year.
